Unravel
a mysterious story

The concept behind Mind Maze is a fairly well known intellectual pastime. A referee describes a strange story and the players must determine why and how the story happened. They do so by asking "Yes or No" questions, with "Not Important" also being a plausible answer.

The key advantage of this game set compared with its predecessors is a new game format that allows players to match up their deductive abilities.

Players take turns asking questions. A point is subtracted each time a player asks a question. Points are awarded for asking certain key questions which allow a player to eliminate a number of faux versions of the story.

The list of useful key questions is attached to every riddle. This sort of gaming procedure effectively encourages players to develop careful analytical questions and eliminates random questions.
